*For one weekend every October, the streets of Mt. Sterling are filled with friends, family, and visitors from across the United States. Music plays, aromas fill the air, and hundreds of vendors offering an abundance of merchandise fill the streets and lots of our historic downtown area! **We'd love for you to join us!***

October Court Day is the oldest outdoor festival in Kentucky. It is an annual open-air market located in Mt. Sterling, held the weekend preceding the 3rd Monday in October. While continuing the over 200-year-old tradition, we strive to make sure the weekend has something for everyone.

To make the October Court Day festival possible, the City of Mt. Sterling closes several downtown streets to traffic and partners with private property owners to rent spaces accommodating vendors.

You'll find folks vending jewelry, apparel, home décor items, art, antiques and culinary items, along with your favorite foods and lots of musical entertainment.
